

SafeChurch[®] Trip Safety Rules Agreement Sample

The following safety rules are designed for use prior to each trip, regardless of whether it is taken in church-owned or private vehicles.

The organizer and/or driver for the trip will ensure all participants read and understand the following "rules for the road":

- Seatbelts must be worn at all times.
- □ No hazardous or disruptive activity or noise will be permitted while the vehicle is moving.
- □ All passengers must follow the driver's instructions.
- Keep all objects inside the vehicle.
- □ All windows must be kept clear of objects that may disrupt the driver's view.
- In case of an accident or emergency, stop; and do not exit the vehicle unless instructed by the driver.
- Always exit on the street side of the vehicle, never on the traffic side.
- Violation of these rules may result in the termination of the trip for the entire group or the removal of a participant from the trip.
- □ The safety of others and my own safety is a priority on this trip.
